Joint Short Staff Training Event (JSSTE) – Aarhus, Denmark

Project teams met for the second time at a joint meeting in Aarhus, Denmark. The date was scheduled for 18.-22. February 2019. All teams arrived in Denmark on Sunday, the day before.

A presentation of participants under the Danish team supervising took place at school. In the morning program, team members focused on technical issues such as printing dictionaries and brochures and the cost of printing them. The participants of the meeting also dealt with the organization and logistics of student mobilities. The main topics were tender of students, budget costs for individual students, dates of virtual conferences before mobilities, formal and informal program of students at the place of residence and their pedagogical accompaniment and also preparation of necessary documents for traveling abroad. In the evening, Danish partners invited meeting participants to a typical Danish restaurant for dinner.







The next day, the morning program was completed with a presentation of Handling Multiculturality in Care and creating dictionares, brochures and video recordings. Turkish team focused attention on dictionary format, correcting mistakes etc. The task of each team was to check the file created by project IT manager Martin. The completed version of the dictionary will be sent to the Turkish partner for final processing and printing. The presentation of *Coming to Denmark as a nurse* was presented to all teams. Furthermore, the teams dealt with the thin and thick versions of upcoming brochures. Teams are required to send a pdf format to the Spanish and Czech partners by the deadline (17.3.). Finally, the teams presented their new videos.

On Wednesday morning the participants visited WELFARE TECHNOLOGY CENTER in Aarhus.



In the afternoon, the teams presented and discussed new versions of the video recordings and worked in mixed groups. On Thursday, Cypriot team members presented information on teaching. The teams also worked to complete the questionnaires.

Teams were planning the schedule of specific student mobility dates in the Friday morning program:

(CZ \rightarrow CYP: 6/10 - 21/10; IZR \rightarrow CYP: 13/10 - 21/10; TUR \rightarrow CZ: 16/9 - 29/9; DEN \rightarrow TUR: 6/10 - 21/10; CYP \rightarrow ESP: 14/9 - 29/9; ESP \rightarrow DEN: 28/10 - 8/11). The tasks were set for the next meeting in Turkey (June 2019): each partner is obliged to make and complete a folder of student mobility, complete the tender of students (May) and create dissemination video (25 - second long).





Each partner answers the question: What is TNP for me? Emphasis must be placed on the quality of the material.



TNP Project meeting in Izmir, Turkey, will be held from 9 to 14 June, 2019.
